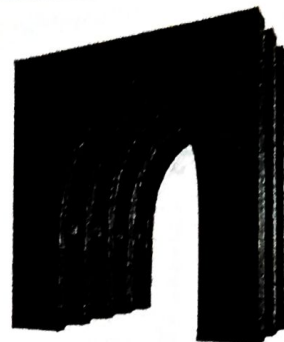


INTRODUCTION

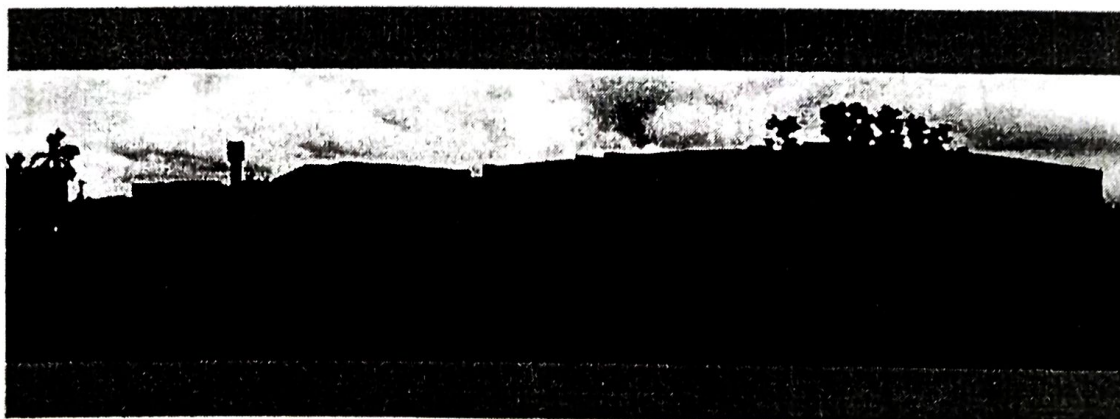

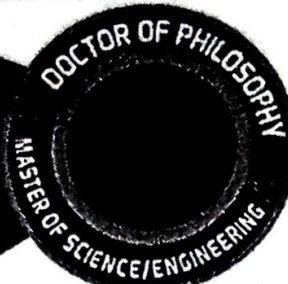
MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS *[Undergraduate]*

- Higher / Upper Secondary / A Level or Equivalent
 - Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry with minimum Grade B (or at least 60% marks) in both secondary and higher secondary levels
 - English with minimum Grade C in Secondary / O Level or Equivalent
- If both marks and grades are available, then selection will be based on grades.

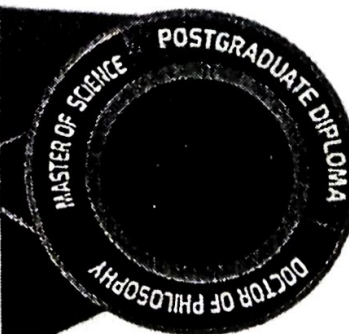

APPLICATION AND NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Nominations of eligible candidates for the programmes are to be sent to IUT in order of merit fulfilling the entry requirement of the programmes and conducted by the Nominating Authority and Focal Points of the Member States of the OIC, by Friday, 29th May 2026 for candidates coming from outside Bangladesh. Applicants having contagious and communicable diseases such as tuberculosis, venereal diseases, AIDS, HIV positive, hepatitis B, hepatitis C etc. are ineligible for admission.

Each nomination should be accompanied with

- Application of the nominee in the prescribed form, available in the office of the Nominating Authority and Focal Points as well as on the website of IUT (<http://admission.iutolc-dhaka.edu>), duly filled in, along with attested copies of academic certificates, mark-sheets / transcript, character certificate and English proficiency certificate (if any).
- Report from an authorized Medical Practitioner on (i) General Fitness (physical and mental) from medical specialist. (ii) Eye examination report from Eye Specialist. (iii) Hearing report from ENT Specialist with audiometry. Laboratory Test with detailed reports; (i) Complete Blood Count (CBC). (ii) Random Blood Sugar (RBS). (iii) Serum Creatinine. (iv) Chest-X-Ray with Report (v) ECG (vi) Blood Group (vii) MT Test (viii) VDRL Report (ix) HBsAg Report (x) HIV Screening Report (xi) Urine RME & C.
Note that dope test shall be taken from IUT Medical centre upon arrival at the student's cost.
- A letter from the nominating authority / guardian assuring that return air-ticket of the graduating student will be sent to the University by first week of his graduating month.
- International students without country nomination will NOT be considered for full or partial OIC scholarship and can apply directly for self-financed scheme.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- The initial selection of the students will be made by the Admission Committee of the University on receipt of nominations from Nominating Authorities, and taking into consideration of their academic qualifications, merit, age, past conduct and geographical distribution.
- In final selection, two stages screening will be done by the admission committee which include IUT EPT test (IUT English Proficiency Test) and ZOOM Interview.

- Payment of 2nd, 3rd and 4th year should be deposited before the start of the new academic year failure of which such student will not be allowed to do exams, or his/her name will not appear on the convocation list.

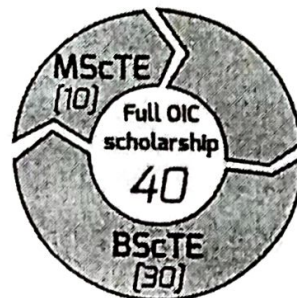

DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIPS/SEATS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

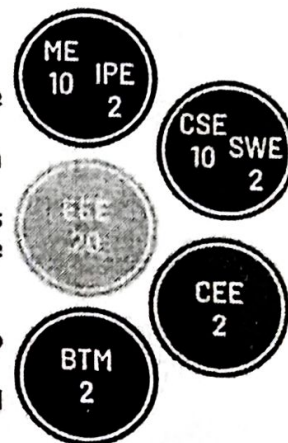
FULL OIC SCHOLARSHIPS

- Engineering programmes: Only for Nominated International Students.
- Technical Education: For both host country and Nominated International Students.
- Scholarships will be distributed among Nominated Eligible Students of member states equally.
- Residential facility for all admitted students.



PARTIAL OIC SCHOLARSHIPS

- For Nominated International Students.
- OIC partial scholarships will be equally distributed among the candidates of the member states applied for admission.
- Unfilled scholarships will be equally distributed to member states with remaining eligible candidates.
- International selected candidates must have to pay their tuition fees of USD \$ 6600 on or before the date that will be indicated in the Offer Letter.
- Residential facility for all admitted students.
- Tuition fees waiver for engineering programs will be awarded to international full time residential postgraduate students.
- One full time residential PhD in TE student will be awarded full scholarship.
